The following points were discussed in the meeting.

- 1) The minutes and action taken report of the IQAC meeting conducted on 11th January 2018 were confirmed.

- 2) Review & Planning of faculty skill development programs, workshops and conferences

Mr. A.D. Bhoi (Coordinator, IQAC) has taken the review of the faculty skilling programs, workshops and conferences conducted in last six months. The following programs were organized.

- I. Two days' Workshop of "Digital Surveying & land mapping" in association with SP Pune University
- II. Two days Workshop on "Supply Chain Management", in association with SP Pune University
- III. National Conference on "Electrifying experiences in electrical Transportation"

Also in last six months 36 faculty were deputed for skill development programs in domains of IoT, Network Security, PLC & SCADA, Total Station Operation and 3 D Printing. IQAC expressed satisfaction for organization of skill development program. Also it was decided to organize the similar programs for next term. Some domains identified are Solar Energy, VLSI design & Piping design. Also it was decided to depute the faculty for skill development programs in industrial safety, IoT, Artificial Intelligence, Flexible Manufacturing Systems, Cloud Computing and Computer Network.

3) Review of the Institute research journal “International journal on Advanced Computing & Knowledge Discovery” (IJACKD)

Prof. N.U. Korde has informed about the college journal (IJACKD). The journal was established in academic year 2012-13. It is annual publication available both in on-line and Print form. It has ISSN registration. The journal is appreciated by renowned researchers and industry person.

IQAC appreciated the activity. The IQAC suggested to have industrial collaboration for IJACKD. Such collaboration will help to improve the quality of journal further and will make it more visible. Dr. Parag Kulkarni advised to approach IT industries like Quick Heal and Tech Mahindra for collaboration.

Dr. R. D. Kharadkar, welcomed the suggestion and assured that the college will take all efforts to have industrial collaboration for IJACKD.

4) Students ‘ Skills (including soft skills) programs and Foreign language coaching

Prof. N.B. Hulle informed that as per suggestions of IQAC college has started the German language training for students. Also college has developed the course for softskill training for F.E. & S.E. students and the same was imparted in last semester. The students’ feedback was good and the training will be continued.

He also informed that apart from soft skills, the technical skill programs were also conducted in last term. The major domains include Python, IoT and Transformer design. Also college has organized aptitude test training and personality development programs for students.

IQAC stressed the need of problem solving approach and project management skills. It was decided to organize the project management program in association with NICMAR.

Also it was decided to offer problem solving course for select student. The selection will be done by conducting the technical and logical abilities test.

- 5) Dr. R. D. Kharadkar told that the college has planned the National Conference on “Computational Intelligence & deep learning (NCCIDL)”. The conference is sponsored by SP Pune University & scheduled between 13th to 15th February 2019.

He also presented the tentative schedule of the conference. IQAC suggested to organize preconference tutorials. Also IQAC suggested the members (renowned academicians & industry persons) for advisory committee.
